

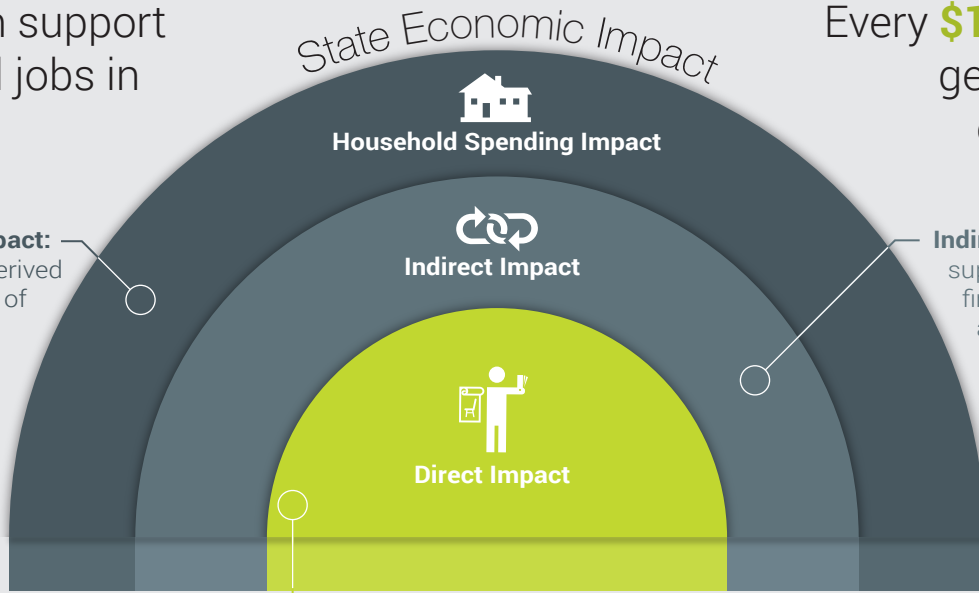
# Louisiana Interior Design Sector\*
